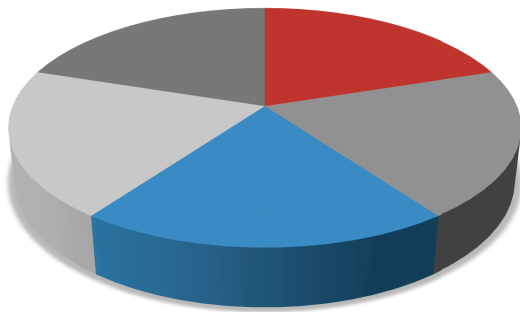




Prevent Sexual Abuse MinistrySafe's 5 Part Safety System

- Skillful Screening Process:** Recognizing high-risk individuals during the hiring and recruiting process
- Policies and Procedures:** Paperless, editable forms that fit your program's unique needs
- Background Checks:** Search of past criminal records, tailored to the applicant's position
- Monitoring and Oversight:** Customizable online management platform

Are the children in your program safe?

90% of victims are abused by someone they know and trust.

- Amber alerts (the "snatch and grab") are a fraction of sexual abuse occurrences.

There is NO visual profile for a sexual abuser.

- Most molesters appear helpful, trustworthy and responsible.
- Abusers look like you and me. Many are married, employed and have families.

Sexual Abuse Awareness Training

- Gives staff members “eyes to see and ears to hear” abuser grooming behaviors
- Explains safety principles behind policies
- Compliant with current and anticipated state legislation

Skillful Screening Process

- Critical component of an effective Safety System
- Includes questions meant to illicit a high-risk response
- Dovetails with MinistrySafe's Sexual Abuse Awareness Training

MinistrySafe provides screening forms and Skillful Screening Training

Background Checks

- Necessary component of an effective Safety System, but not a “silver bullet”
- Depth of background check should match nature of access to children

MinistrySafe provides online resources for effective monitoring and oversight

Policies and Procedures

- Policies are what you DO—not what you SAY you do
- Policies should be tailored to programming; there is no one-size-fits-all form
- Policies are marginally effective without Awareness Training

Monitoring and Oversight

- Ensuring that you DO what you SAY you do
- Periodic review of the Safety System to ensure accountability
